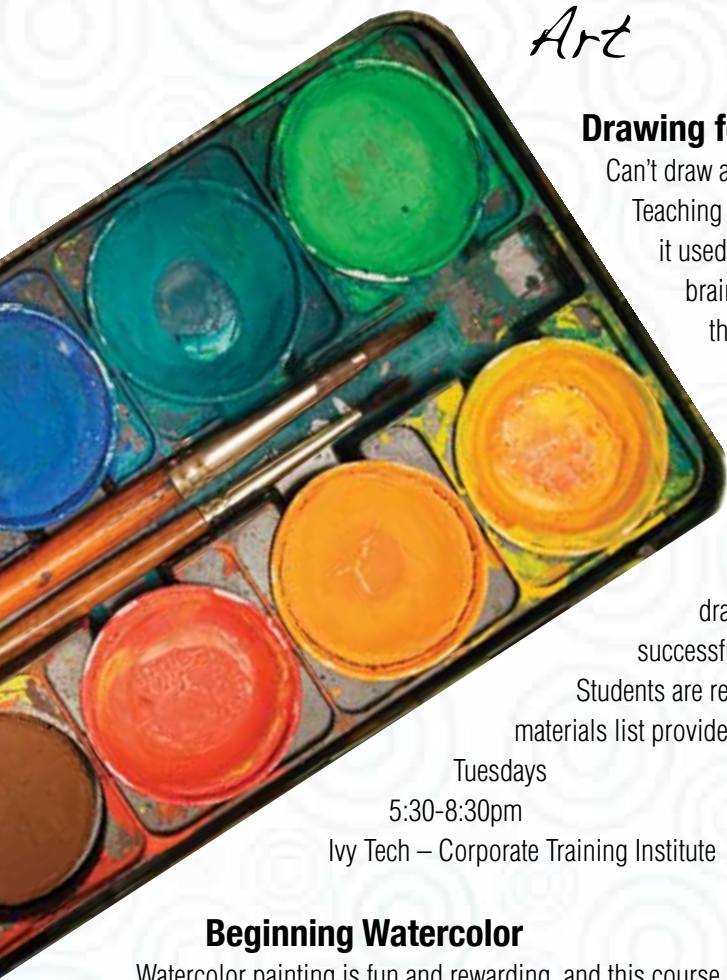

Introduction to Guitar Playing

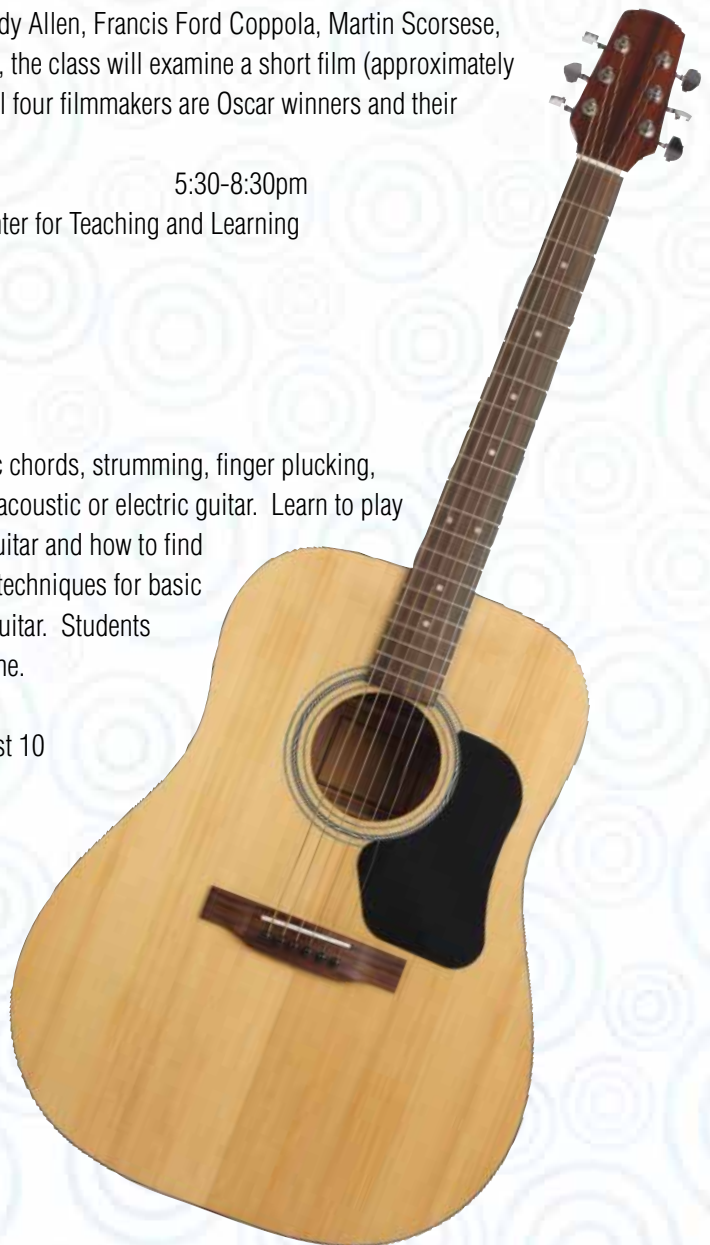

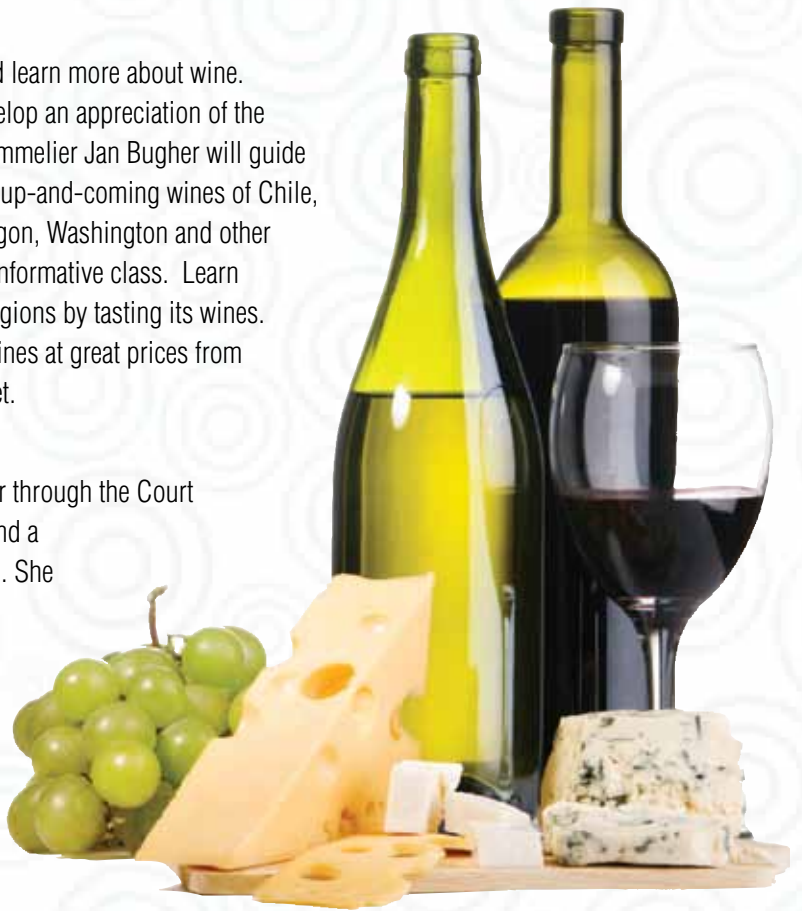


Wine Appreciation
